The Pembroke Pines Charter High School Key Club is a coeducational service organization for high school students, organized & sponsored by the Kiwanis Club of Greater Pembroke Pines. Key Club is a self-governing organization that elects its own officers, determines its own service activities, & establishes its own dues structure. Key Club International is the largest high school service organization the world and consists of 250,000 Key Club members in 5,000 high schools and 30 countries.

Our school's Key Club was chartered on December 20, 2001. Key Club is one of a family of Kiwanis Sponsored Youth service organizations that can be found in elementary, middle, and high schools, and colleges. The word "Key" stands for *Kiwanis Educating Youth*.

Key Club is primarily a service organization, which also provides its members with leadership opportunities and social events. Members are expected to regularly attend every-other week club meetings (some flexibility allowed for sports and other conflicting seasonal activities) and participate in service and fundraising projects, which may occur in the community and away from the school campus.
